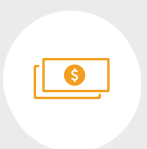
YOUTH MINISTRIES

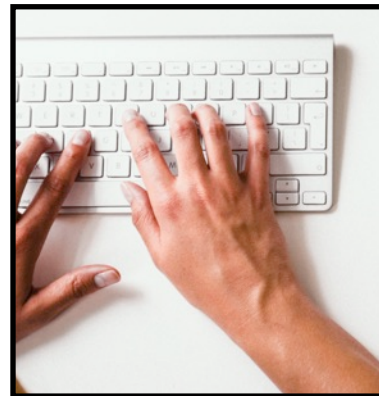
