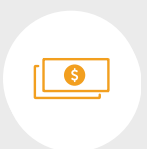
Greeters

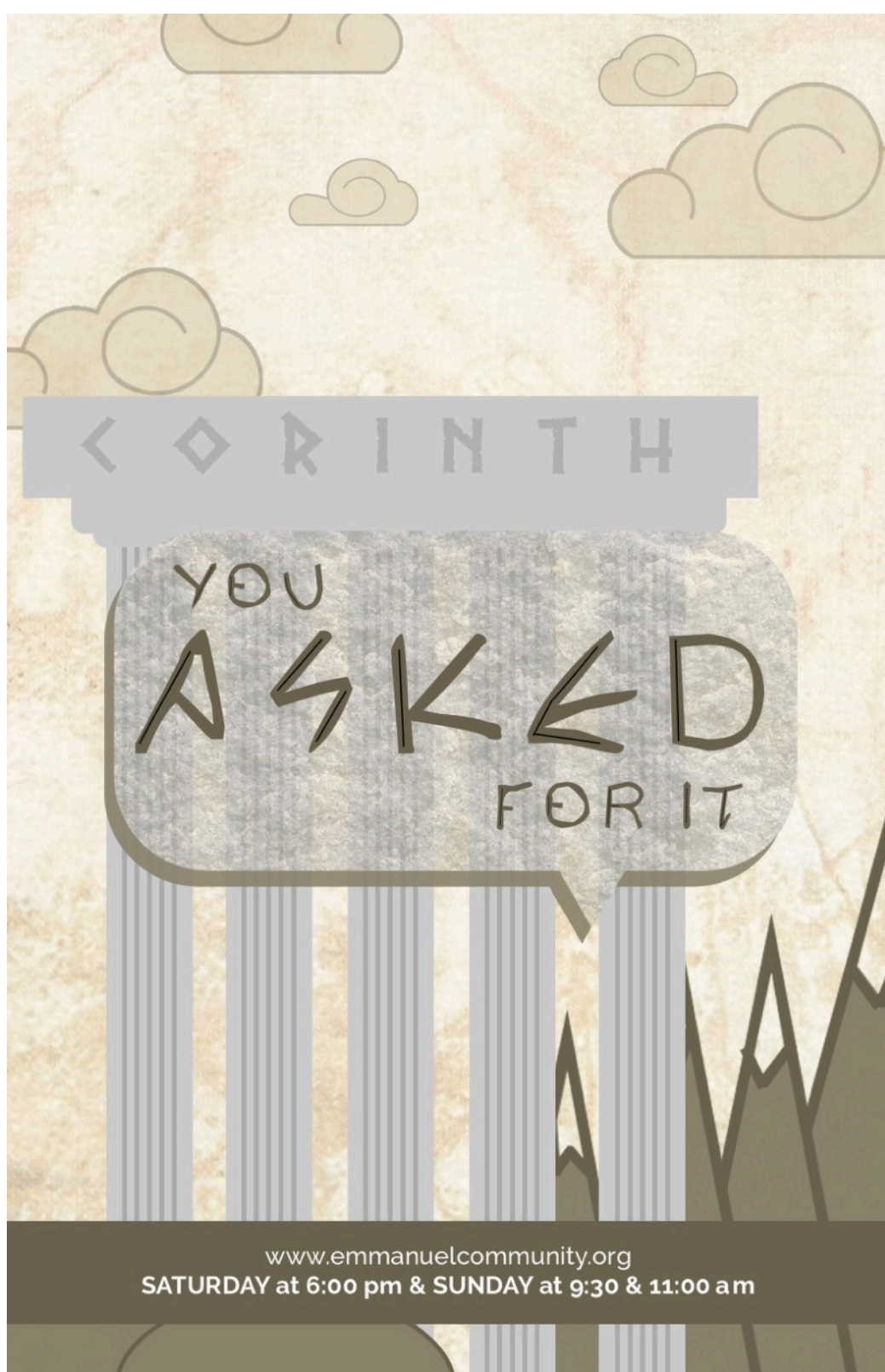
