- 5. We tend to think of destructive actions and patterns in our lives as how they affect or influence us. How is God affected by any 'dark' choices in our walk?
- 6. We have varied types of experiences with our earthly fathers. What steps can we take to ensure our image of God as Father is true to His revealed nature?
